

This introductory dermoscopy workshop is intended for GPs, GPSIs and Drs who wish to improve their dermoscopy skills. It is targeted at those clinicians performing, or planning to perform dermoscopy to assist in the management of skin lesions in primary care. Core aspects of dermoscopy will be covered from instrument selection, scope and limitations, classical features and problem areas.
