

This skin surgical skills course is for GPs, GPSIs and Drs who wish to improve their surgical skills; ideally those performing or planning to perform skin surgery in primary care. All aspects of skin surgery will be covered from planning, marking of lesions, injecting, cutting, suturing techniques, skin flaps, z plasty etc and anything else delegates would like to know or practice. All skill levels are catered for ('novice to 'advanced'). Pig skin and novel jigs give a realistic feel to the surgery.

The course is being held in the luxury boutique Malmaison Hotel in the heart of Birmingham, that is a part of the 'Mailbox' complex with its designer stores and chic bars/cafés.
